The data in the application form is pre-filled according to the user account in InSIS, only the phone number and, if a tax document (invoice) is required, the billing data are to be entered. After clicking on the **Sign up for the course** button, you will be redirected to the course application payment and through the option **Online payment** to the payment gateway. 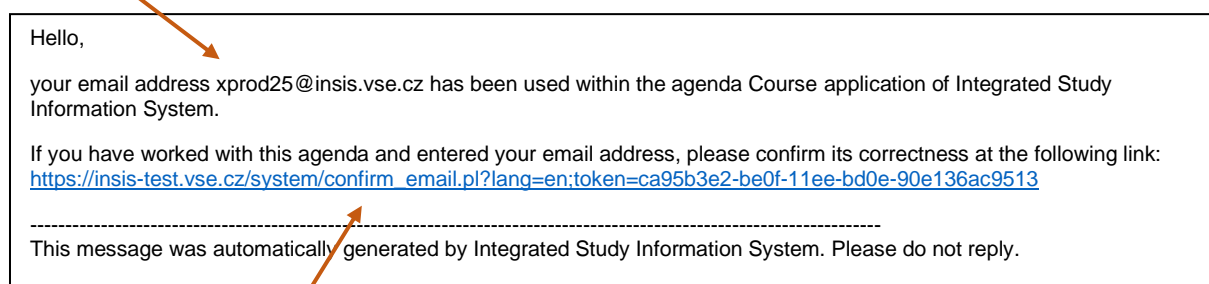

2. Creation of application by administrator on behalf of applicant (who is not a graduate, student or employee)


Some FIR courses may have specific arrangements for the application process. These are, for example, courses in cooperation with another higher education institution, in cooperation with the business sector, or generally courses for which the selection procedure is different from the standard procedure described above.

In these cases, the application, which is the basis for a user account in VŠE systems, is created by the course administrator. The structure of the application form is identical to the one submitted directly by the applicant. It is therefore essential that the mandatory information about the applicant is available to the administrator. After the application is created by the administrator (FIR administration), the applicant receives an email inviting them to verify their email address.

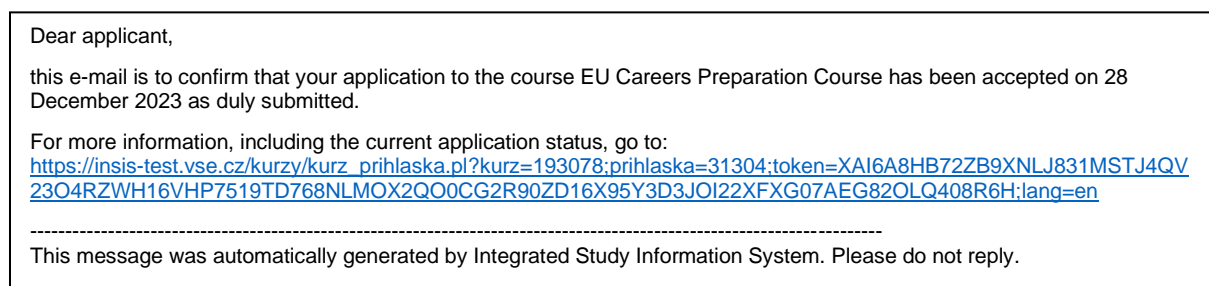


After clicking on the link, the applicant is redirected to InSIS, where a confirmation of email address verification is displayed.

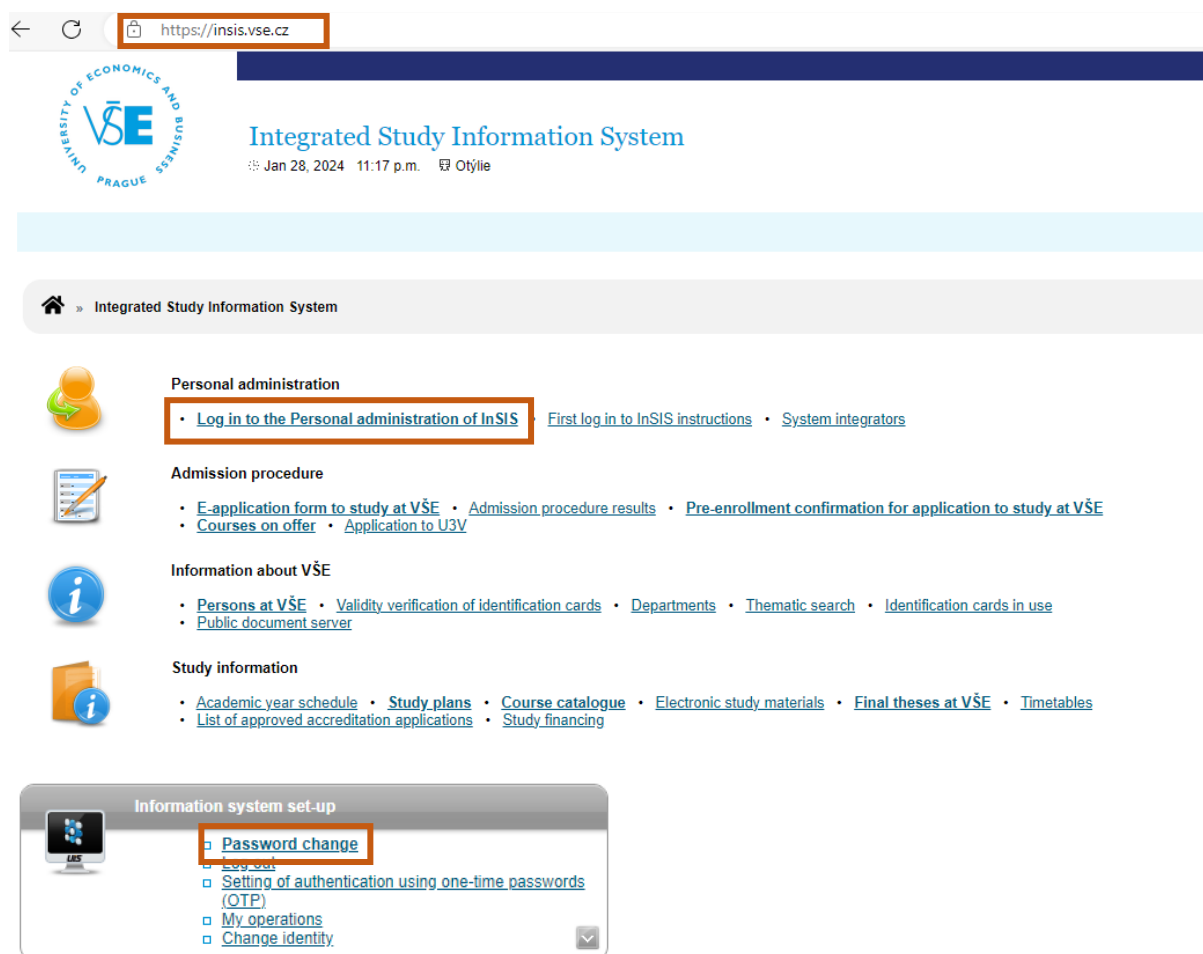

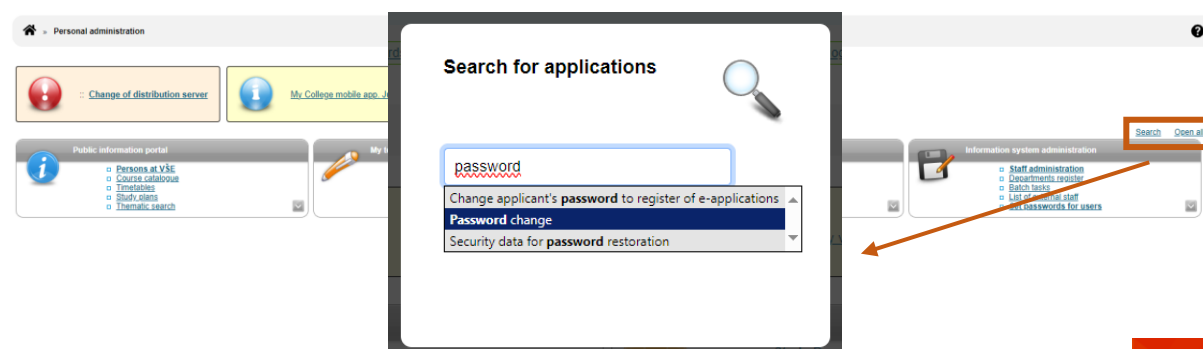
3. Login to VŠE systems

3.1. InSIS login and password change

The password you receive when you create a new user account together with your user name is temporary. It must be changed, but not earlier than 2 days after the account is created. This can be done in InSIS at <https://insis.vse.cz/?lang=en>, after logging in to **Personal administration** (which you log in to with the received login details), in the **Information System Settings - Change password** section. If you cannot find the Change Password application, you can search for it using the Search function in the top right corner of the Personal Administration.




If you cannot find the Password change app, you can search for it using the Search function in the top-right corner of Personal administration.



When changing your password, it is necessary that you **meet all the requirements** for a new password.

Password change











This application helps you to change your password. You need to type in the original password once (for safety reasons) and the new password twice (passwords do not appear). This way the number of typing errors can be reduced.

 Your password can be restored without the original password by logging in the information system using the eID.

Safe password

Your new password must meet the requirements stated below. Suitable password contains several words, digits and special characters. Selected words should have no connection to you or to university - proper names, dates or geographical names can be easily guessed. Also avoid very simple passwords, such as successions (1234, qwerty) or simple words (password, login). Substituting characters for letters, such as @ for a, or \$ for s, doesn't make the password any stronger.

Password requisites

-  Minimum length of password is 12 characters.
-  Minimum number of small letters is 1.
-  Minimum number of capital letters is 1.
-  Minimum number of letters is 5.
-  Minimum number of non-letter characters is 2.
-  Maximum number of consecutive identical characters is 2.
-  Password must be very strong.
-  The alternative to meeting the required minimum of digits, letters, etc. is a password containing at least 30 characters, including no fewer than 5 various characters.
-  Number of old passwords that the new password must be different from is 10.
-  Minimum number of changes compared to old password is 7.

Diacritics is prohibited (only ASCII characters are allowed).

You can choose your own password (meeting all defined requirements), or use one of the randomly generated ones.

You can enter your own password or click and choose one of the secure system-generated passwords.

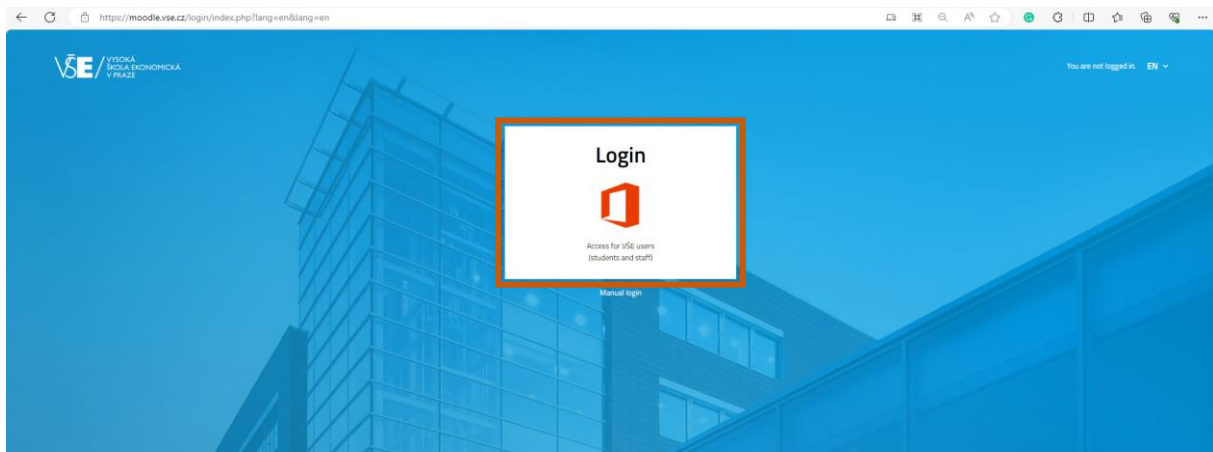
